Personal Data Protection Policy

The European Union's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into force on 25th May 2018, providing you with rights to control the collection and use of your personal data. Your privacy is important to us, and we are committed to protecting your personal information. We have therefore derived a policy by which we are letting you know about the ways we collect and use your information as a member of EPA, so you can make an informed choice regarding whether you wish to make changes.

1. Personal data shall only be collected from the members in order for EPA to meet its objectives as stated in its Charter.
2. Personal data shall only be processed if deemed necessary and in accordance with the pre-defined terms.
3. In order to ensure that the personal data are not kept longer than necessary, time limits will be established by the EPA Committee for deletion in an appropriate manner.
4. Every effort will be made to ensure that personal data which is inaccurate is corrected or deleted.
5. Personal data shall be processed in a manner that ensures appropriate security and confidentiality of the said data, including the prevention of unauthorised access to or use of personal data and the equipment used for processing.
6. Personal data shall not be transferred to other organisations, unless this is considered necessary to fulfil the objectives of the Association, or EPA is obliged to do so by an applicable law.
7. Members reserve the right to request access to their personal data, to ask for it to be corrected or deleted ("the right to be forgotten") and to have it provided to them in a machine-readable format ("data portability").
